

U Innovation & The Launch Pad

U Innovation is the hub of the Universities departments aimed at transforming the 'CANE community through entrepreneurial efforts.

One of President Frenks' 5 initiatives, U Innovation is the department of where The Launch Pad is housed. This allows or office to maintain the campus and beyond wide impact alongside other offices that are trailblazers in facilitating change.

This includes the <u>Office of Technology</u> **Transfer** who's interest is to protect the rights of the University of Miami by supporting the legal collaboration of the Universities intellectual property and trademark rights.

Along with the Wallace H. Coulter Center for Translational Research which helps by filling in the funding gaps specifically for basic science within the biomedical field. It is a translational resource that only works with business that are protected by the University and has at least 2 to 3 years left to commercialization.

Finally the 'Cane Angel Network is a fund that invests in early stage ventures with the support of its members. These members are made up of anyone affiliated with the University including parents.

The essence of entrepreneurship spans greater than these departments. That is why we partner with as many organizations, offices, and schools to help spread the range of both entrepreneurial and intrapreneurial opportunities.
